

How the Bible is proven inspired by Astronomy

While men, scholars, students of nature, were still saying the earth was flat, in the days of the Bible times of the ancient cultures.

This happened in the Old Testament era, 384-322 BC in every civilization minus Israel. Yet in this time period the Word of God said...

In 1033-975 B.C. Prov 8:27 "When He established the heavens, I was there, When He inscribed a circle on the face of the deep." The deep has a circler design. Not possible for a 1-dimensional flat shape.

In 745-695 B.C. Isa 40:22 "It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, And its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain And spreads them out like a tent to dwell in."

Gen 1:7 "So God made the dome and separated the waters that were under the dome from the waters that were above the dome."

People in long lost civilizations thought the earth had a giant turtle or some other beast carrying it. Yet the wise men of that day had it wrong, and again the Bible written long ago had it right.

In 2,000 B.C. Job 26:7 "He stretches out the north over empty space And hangs the earth on nothing." (1)

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Intellectual scholars of the age, like Hipparchus B.C. 150 and Ptolemy A.D. 150 thought the stars were small in number, around 3,000. Long before telescopes and satellites to see the billions upon billion, upon billions, etc, the Bible says...Jer 33:22 “As the host of heaven cannot be counted and the sand of the sea cannot be measured...” The philosophers and sages of the old civilizations did not acknowledge this, yet the Bible says the stars produce sound, the term sing in Hebrew means “ranan” to emit a load creak, shrill or strenuous sound. Before technology to hear such, before men could, God said His creation, the stars did.

In 2,000 B.C. Job 38:7 “When the morning stars sang together.”
The ancient nations, thought the sun, moon, stars, of the sky were “god’s” or the like.

Only the Bible makes a distinction and says they themselves are light and illuminated internally. The Bible word, “moar” in the below verse, literally means light container. *In 1491-1451 B.C. Genesis 1:16 “God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night; He made the stars also. 17 God placed them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, 18 and to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good.” (2)*

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
