Ways to practice giving an invite:

Role-playing -

Start first with one of the exercises below

- You can simply do nothing more than just come up to someone and give an invite to church or a Bible study, can give a person a card.
- You can introduce yourself and share your church, then give a church invite card or your Bible study invite card. An example of what evangelist Max Dawson does is, "My name is Max, and I worship at Dowlen Rd. Church, I'd love for you to come by and visit." And then he gives that person a card.
- You can ask someone a question to get a response and a discussion going.
 Then given an invite. You can think of questions to ask ahead of time. The more you do this method the easier it gets.
- You can ask someone a question to get a response and a discussion going. When asking questions to generate a conversation, transition to talking to people about spiritual things, like sharing one's salvation experience or Bible scripture on heavenly truths like church, salvation, etc. Then give an invite to a Bible study or church. The more you practice this the easier it is to do this.

After the exercise is done: Then do the Star Bible invite:

(Later – we can also try the "One Shot" approach method)

- Star Bible method (Using Star Bible and Salvation Highway Flow chart)
 - 1. First you ask a question to get a conversation going.
 - 2. Then transition the conversation to spiritual things.
 - 3. Then ask the question "If Jesus were to come today, would you be sure without a doubt that you'd go to heaven?"
 - 4. Then if they respond positively, you ask "Are you a Christian?"
 - 5. If they say "yes," then ask for their "salvation story."
 - 6. Ask questions to learn in detail "where," "when" and "how" they were "saved." Learn if they said the sinner's prayer for salvation. Learn if they were baptized and why. Afterward, ask if you can share your "salvation story."
 - 7. If they say "no" that they are not a Christian, ask them if you can share your "salvation story?"
 - "If they say "yes" that they are a Christian, ask if you can share your "salvation story?"
 - 8. Then share how you were saved using the Star Bible. When you do this with people you meet: Have two Star Bibles, one for you and one for them.
